- For this activity you will need a pen or pencil to outline the words once they are found.


FOOD

- 14. These come from chickens






ANIMALS

- 11. A small furry animal with whiskers and a tail






EVERYDAY OBJECTS

- 9. This gets out creases in clothes






MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

- **8.** A brass instrument with a curved body and a reed mouthpiece.
- **10.** A large keyboard instrument with keys that produce sound from hammers striking strings.

Down


- 1. A stringed instrument played with a bow.
- **2.** A woodwind instrument played by blowing air across a hole in the side of the instrument.
- **3.** A brass instrument that is played by blowing air through a cup-shaped mouthpiece.
- **7.** A stringed instrument with a long neck and a round body, often used in folk music.
- **9.** A large, stringed instrument played by plucking strings with the fingers.






